

Audition Guidelines for Jean Lewis Scholarship

1. Audition materials should be 8-10 minutes in length.
2. The selection must be a solo performance of prose or poetry, a play cutting, monologue, or a musical selection, and can be either dramatic or comedic.
3. A brief introduction is needed and should include title, author, setting and any other necessary information.
4. Scripts, properties, set pieces, make-up or costumes may be used, but are not required. Applicants must provide their own music, if needed.
5. If applying in other than a performance area, the Scholarship Committee will contact the applicant as to what procedures to follow in lieu of audition.
